Camp Indy Summer Discipline Procedures

At Camp Indy our desire is to have fun, learn, and serve Jesus in all that we do. We strive to have an environment that is safe and yet enjoyable. The following is Camp Indy's procedural plan on walking through disciplinary situations.

Ten Strong Suggestions EVERY Camper Should Follow:

- 1. Always listen to your counselor!
- 2. No rock or stick throwing.
- 3. No swearing or name-calling.
- 4. No hitting, pushing, or fighting.
- 5. Always wear your shoes!
- 6. If there is a problem, find a counselor.
- 7. Never walk off alone (counselors must know where you are at all times).
- 8. No radios, CD players, Mp3 players, iPods, cell phones, PSPs, or other electronic devices.
- 9. No drugs or alcohol.
- 10. Enjoy Jesus!

*Levels of Minor Offences

- 1. Misbehavior is corrected by a counselor. Camper is made aware of the rule broken, is asked to fix behavior, and is informed of the next step of disciplinary procedure if behavior is not corrected.
- 2. Camper sits out for a specified amount of time from the current or next activity. Behavior is again requested to be fixed and the next step of disciplinary procedure is explained to the camper.
- 3. Camper is assigned a task to accomplish alongside their counselor. Parents are called and informed of camper misbehavior and task being accomplished.

*Strikes

- 1. Verbal Warning Camper is informed of misbehavior and its severity. A verbal warning form is filled out and given to parents.
- 2. Written Warning Camper is informed of misbehavior and its severity. Camper is removed from camp privileges and walks alongside an assistant/director for further guidance.
- 3. Termination of Camp Participation Camper is asked not to return to camp.

*Severe Clause

Camp Indy reserves the right to skip or repeat any step outlined in the disciplinary procedure plan. Campers dismissed from camp for any reason will not receive a refund of payments made to attend camp.
